Hello Jim,

As we have discussed, it is perfectly acceptable to pack the DOLPHIN reserve container using the same closing sequence as the JAVELIN. During the testing of the DOLPHIN we packed the reserve containers with the top and bottom flaps over the pilot chute, and with only the top flap over the pilot chute; and there was no discernible difference in the deployments with either pack method. I hope this information will be helpful to you, if you need any more, we will be happy to provide what we can.
